A proposed date for work to begin is in the spring. The proposal has already met county review, and all aspects of the plan, including drainage and driveway access, seemed satisfactory.

- *Discussion on a township data center ordinance.* Model language for such an ordinance was not available in time for the meeting, and the matter was tabled until April.
